The parents among you will know the old saying "There comes a time when you've got to let them go". Thankfully, for our offspring, this merely means cutting the apron strings and letting them make their own way in the world. However, the same saying has a completely different meaning for horse-owners and a great many owners find it too unbearable to contemplate – so they put their animals on loan instead.

Get references, verify them, take photographs of the loanee, research them on the internet, draw up a legally binding contract, visit regularly and keep in touch. If you can't find the time or inclination to do this for your old faithful friend you have to ask yourself if loaning is really for you.

Safe loaning is not a quick-fix, short-term solution to be used as a substitute for making the final decision over your horse's future. And even with the best will in the world you could still fall foul of unscrupulous characters.
